



Young or New Investigator Awards

Overview of Awards: Two tiers of Young or New Investigator Awards will be offered to qualifying individuals at World Sleep 2019. The first-tier award will provide the opportunity for up to 18 individuals to present their abstract during a special Young or New Investigator oral abstract session. The second-tier awards will be presented to authors of the top ranked Young or New Investigator poster abstracts.

Requirement: 35 years old or younger **OR** less than 5 years post MD or PhD degree

First tier award: Complementary registration and a travel grant of up to \$1,000 USD (depending on distance of travel) to give a 10-minute oral presentation included in a special oral abstract session during the congress.

Second tier award: Monetary award of \$400 USD per winning poster

Deadline: June 15, 2019

Review Process

The young or new investigator awards will be selected from submitted abstracts. Abstracts submitted by award applicants will be evaluated in two phases:

Phase 1 (General abstract review): Award applicants will be notified of their acceptance for an oral or poster presentation. Acceptance of an oral or poster abstract **does not** imply the author will be selected to receive a young or new investigator award.

Phase 2 (Young or New Investigator abstract review): Following the June 15, 2019 deadline, the applications will be reviewed, and award recipients will be notified by June 30, 2019.
